

Pursuant to Article IV.4.a) of the Constitution of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Parliamentary Assembly of Bosnia and Herzegovina, at the 79th session of its House of Representatives, held on 18 May 2006, and 59th session of its House of Peoples, held on 20 June 2006, adopted the

LAW

ON AMENDMENTS AND ADDENDA TO THE CUSTOMS POLICY LAW OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

Article 1

In the Customs Policy Law of Bosnia and Herzegovina (Official Gazette of BiH, No. 57/04) in Article 176, Paragraph 3, after Item (b) a full stop shall be deleted, adding conjunction “or” and a new Item (c) to read:

“(c) in a larger part financed by foreign donors or International Development Banks and smaller part from the budget.”

In the same Article, after Paragraph 3 shall be added new paragraph 4, to read:

“4. Equipment released for free circulation, intended for production activities in a free zone, shall be relieved from import duty”.

Former Paragraph 4 shall become Paragraph 5.

In the former Paragraph 5, becoming now paragraph 6, number “4”, shall be replaced by number “5”.

Article 2.

This Law shall enter into force as of the day of its publishing in the “Official Gazette of BiH”.
